Overview

The Basic CISM training program is designed to present the core elements of a comprehensive, systematic and multi-component crisis intervention curriculum. The two-day course prepares participants to understand a wide range of crisis intervention services including pre and post incident crisis education, significant other support services, on-scene support services, crisis intervention for individuals, demobilizations after large-scale traumatic incidents, small group defusings and the group intervention program known as Critical Incident Stress Debriefing (CISD). The Basic CISM course prepares participants to provide several of these interventions, specifically demobilizations, defusings and debriefings, and the need for appropriate follow-up services and referrals (when necessary) is also described. There is considerable evidence that strongly supports the multi-component crisis intervention strategy, which is discussed in this course.

The Basic CISM training is open to any person who wishes to know more about crisis intervention techniques. Emergency and disaster service workers, security, safety, military, industrial and school system personnel, EAPs, human resources personnel, Mental Health Professionals and others can benefit from the information provided this basic CISM training.
